

Focus on Effectiveness: Strategic Plan Midpoint Survey Results

At the halfway point in our five-year strategic plan, the provost asked all divisional vice presidents and their leadership teams to provide their observations and perspectives on our progress. This input confirmed that we have made headway on our strategic priorities, while the comments provided direction for our focus over the next year. This summary shows the rating of our progress toward achieving each goal and the strategy associated with each goal that was considered by respondents to be the highest priority for the coming year.
